

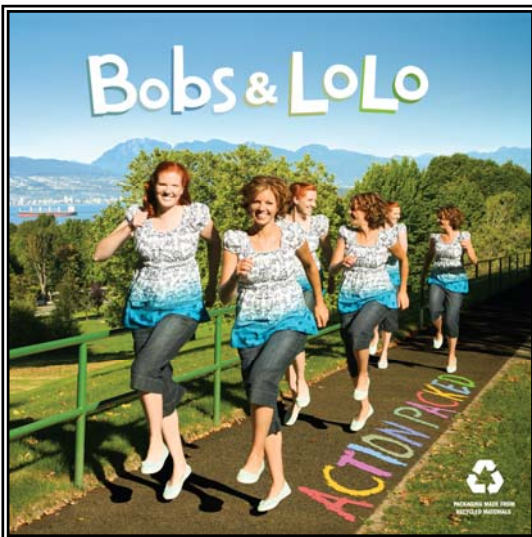


# Bobs & Lolo
